All Volunteers Will Abide By a Code of Conduct Which Includes the Following Provisions

ALL LEAGUE VOLUNTEERS SHALL:

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- Not smoke and/or use smokeless tobacco on game or practice fields, or within the sight of any participants.
- Abstain from possession of alcoholic beverages and/or use of any illegal substance at practice and/or a game. I also will not consume alcohol for a minimum of 8 hours prior to any game, practice, conditioning camp, or any RAJC organized functions.
- Not attempt to be verbally abusive, intimidating, or threatening to others, flagrantly rude with officials, board members, other coaches, members/guests or volunteers.
- Not physically assault anyone at all. The term physical assault includes, but is not limited to: hitting, slapping, pushing, spitting, kicking or striking in any way with any part of the body or any physical implement.
- Not recommend or distribute any medication, controlled or over-the-counter to any participant.
- If applicable to their position, immediately remove from the game or practice any participant, when there is even the slightest doubt about his/her health, whether or not as a result of injury, until competent medical advice is available.
- If applicable to their position, not permit an ineligible player to participate in a game.
- If applicable to their position, be jointly responsible for the conduct and control of team fans and spectators, along with team officials.
- Not criticize the players in front of the spectators or other players. (other than constructive criticism).
- Not criticize any opposing team, its players, coaches, or fans by word of mouth or gesture.
- Accept the decisions of the game officials on the field.
- Not receive any payment in cash or in-kind for services as a league volunteer.

PROFESSIONALISM

- Not deliberately incite any disruptive conduct.
- Not yell at, threaten, or berate any referee, league official, player, parent, coach or volunteer.
- Not swear at or curse or use threatening or abusive language towards any RAJC player, parent, official, referee, coach or other volunteer. (definition of this is by the determination / discretion of the RAJC Board of Directors)
- When instructed to copy the league on any team correspondence, do so. Cease team communication when ordered by the league to do so.
- Not start nor repeat any gossip, rumors, lies or other comments and statements.
- Obey any verbal instruction or order given by the president or vice president, board member, league director, area director, coach, team mom as it pertains to your position in this chain of command.
- Realize that the league is before the team. Without the league, there is no team. Know that I as a RAJC volunteer, represent the RAJC first, then the team second. Any concerns, disputes, or questions should be immediately brought to the association's attention, and I will not incite disagreements or choose sides or promote dissent. I will defend the association/league and its decisions.
- Be responsible for team web-site content and agree that site content must be approved by the RAJC Board of Directors.
- Emphasize to its players and volunteers that winning and the success of the league is a result of good teamwork.
- Teach and practice the guidelines for good sportsmanship found on the RAJC web-site. Set good sportsmanship examples. (it will be decided by the RAJC Board of Directors if a volunteer is or is not doing this)
- Volunteers are to uphold all the rules, codes and regulations set forth by the RAJC. Any infraction of the above codes or other rules will result in a guideline of disciplinary action as follows... first offense: a volunteer will be asked to leave the premise and receive a written warning regarding their behavior. If the volunteer commits a second similar offense, he will be banned from all events for the remainder of the season.
- If a volunteer physically assaults an official, player, coach, board member, volunteer or parent, he will be banned from any RAJC events for one year from the date of the incident. If the volunteer commits a second physical assault, he/she will be permanently banned from all RAJC/NFYFCC events, as a volunteer, and as a parent. (seriousness of any violation as determined by the RAJC BOD may dictate more serious penalties regardless of when and how many offenses have taken place. This is at the discretion of the RAJC BOD/NFYFCC BOD)

I have read and accept all of the statements written above and agree to abide by them, understanding that they are my code of conduct for my position as an RAJC volunteer. If I fail to do so, I may be subject to certain penalties as set by the RAJC BOD at any time.

I acknowledge that the volunteers in the RAJC are held in the highest regard, and the utmost character, integrity, and professionalism is expected of me as a volunteer.
